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From the Principal

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Following the shortest first term anyone can remember, we are back for a longer Term 2 that will go through until June 24. 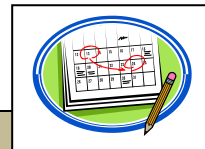
